OUTSIDE SERVICES MANAGER VILLAGE **DAVID CORDERO**



GOLF RULES 2023-2024

In order for all members and guests to enjoy their experience, we ask that you please be mindful of the traditions of golf, a game of courtesy and etiquette. In addition, please familiarize yourself with the following rules regarding play, fees, and other pertinent information. This will help allow us to deliver a premier experience.

GOLF COURSE AVAILABILITY & TEE TIMES

Live Tee Sheet Availability up to seven (7) days in advance of respective day

• Members may access the tee sheet to reserve, modify or edit a tee time up to seven (7) days in advance beginning at 8:00am.

Advance Requests up to fourteen (14) days in advance of respective day (available for twosomes, threesomes, foursomes)

- Members may enter a request up to fourteen (14) days in advance of the respective day.
- Members may link up to five (5) groups to ensure consecutive tee times of the five groups.
- Members may input a maximum of one (1) "X" into each respective tee time, with the "X" going away seventy-two (72) hours in advance.
- Assigned times will be based on the average weighting of the group with a rolling average of time requested versus time received.
- The tee sheet will become live at 8:00am each day, seven days in advance of the respective day.
- Further information may be found on the previously communicated FAO's.

STARTING & CONTINUING PLAY

- •Members are required to check in with the Starter prior to teeing off, and all play shall commence on Hole #1, unless otherwise advised. All play must be in sequential hole order.
- •Should you receive approval to begin play on Hole #10 or any other hole, your position may not be held for you when you make the turn to Hole #1, as you must wait for any groups that are in queue on Hole #1.
- •Should any players or groups stop after 9-holes, they will lose their position on the course. Players must gain permission from the Professional Staff and/or Starter to continue play.

- Playing out of sequence or skipping holes on the golf course is not permitted unless given permission from the Professional Staff and/or Starter.
- Fivesomes are not permitted unless permission is granted from the Director of Golf or Head Golf Professional(s).
- A maximum of two golf carts shall be permitted in any group.
- Environmentally Sensitive Areas (USGA Model Local Rule E-8.2): The areas within the red stakes with green tips throughout the respective course(s) are a no play zone. When a ball is in the no play zone, the ball must not be played as it lies and relief must be taken from interference by the no play zone under Rule 17.1e. Players are also prohibited from entering the area.
- Singles and twosomes have no special standing on the course to pass other players.
- Foursomes shall have the right of way.
- One set of clubs is required for each player.
- The Club is not responsible for any injury sustained by an individual or damage to property as a result of being struck by a golf ball.

GENERAL ETIQUETTE & PACE OF PLAY GOLF COURSE CARE

BUNKERS

- · Golfers should rake all bunkers after use.
- Rakes should be laid flat outside the bunker's edge.
- Golfers should click the sand off their shoes prior to approaching the green.

• All divots must be replaced with the respective sand.

BALL MARKS

• Please repair your respective ball mark on the green.

RANGE BALLS

• The use of range balls anywhere outside the practice facilities is prohibited.

MOBILE PHONES

• The discreet use of mobile phones is required and phones shall be on silent/vibrate mode.

PACE OF PLAY

VILLAGE

• Four (4) hours, five (5) minutes

MEDAL

• Four (4) hours, five (5) minutes

MATCH

• Four (4) hours, zero (0) minutes

GOLF CARTS & WALKING

· All golf cart operators must be at least sixteen years of age and have a valid, state issued driver's license.

MEDAL & MATCH COURSE: YEAR ROUND

• Walking or using a push or electrical walking cart is permitted at any time.

VILLAGE COURSE: NOVEMBER - APRIL

• Walking or using a push cart or electrical walking cart is permitted after 2:00pm.

VILLAGE COURSE: MAY - OCTOBER

- Walking or using a push cart or electrical walking cart is permitted after 12:00pm.
- Club owned golf carts shall be used for play only and returned each day to the respective facility and staff.
- The cost of repair of a Club owned cart, if damaged by negligence, will be charged to the Member or in the case of a guest, to the sponsoring Member. Operation of the cart is at the risk of the operators.
- Disability Access:
- Cart Path Only Days (Medal Course only): when designated, disability access will not be granted.
- Juniors ages 16 & under will not be charged a golf cart fee.
- Golf carts are limited to two (2) adults per cart.
- Golf carts are not allowed to be left in the parking lot or practice areas, and shall be returned to the staging area, unless otherwise directed.
- No more than two golf carts shall be permitted in a group. Twosomes must use one golf cart.

PRIVATELY OWNED GOLF CART – TRAIL FEE

- Members who reside at Jonathan's Landing shall have the right to purchase an annual trail fee for their privately owned golf carts.
- Any guest who rides in a member owned golf cart, shall incur the respective golf cart fee.
- The right to use a privately owned golf cart on Club property is a non-transferable and non-assignable personal privilege that is granted at the Club's discretion only to Members. This right is subject to the Club's Rules & Regulations and may be revoked or suspended by the Board of Directors. To qualify for this privilege, the Member must:
- Own and maintain the golf cart
- Pay the respective annual trail fee

- Present the golf cart for inspection to the Club employee who is designated by the Club
- Display the current year decal
- Provide the Club with proof of insurance coverage as required by the Club
- Execute and deliver to the Club an Annual Trail Rights Agreement for the current year
- Use the golf cart while playing golf at either the Village course or the Old Trail courses
- Members who use a privately owned golf cart shall be granted a club owned golf cart for use to play at the opposing facility from which they reside
- Members who have an additional member on the membership, who is using their golf cart to play golf, shall be entitled to a club owned golf cart for play and/or practice
- Members whose golf cart is out of service and/or being repaired, may use a club owned golf cart for play and/or practice however MUST RETURN THE CLUB OWNED GOLF CART TO THE STAFF EACH DAY (i.e. may not take the golf cart home)

NON-RESIDENT ANNUAL CART FEE - TRAIL FEE

- Members not residing at Jonathan's Landing have the right to purchase an annual Cart Fee (trail fee) which shall permit all those on the membership the same applicable privileges as stated in the residing member's rights for the Trail Fee.
- All respective golf cart rules including applicable golf cart signage must be obeyed.

GUESTS

- Members must register daily guests for play. Members bear the responsibility for the actions of their guests.
- NOVEMBER APRIL Prior to 11:00am, irrespective of the day, a member may host one guest on any of the courses at the respective guest rate.
- NOVEMBER APRIL After 11:00am, irrespective of the day, a member may host a maximum of three guests at the respective guest rate. No other requests shall be permitted.
- **NOVEMBER APRIL** Any group(s) containing one member and two or more guests on the Match Course must take a Forecaddie at a minimum.
- MAY OCTOBER Before 11:00am, irrespective of the day, a member may host up to three guests at one time at the respective guest rate.
- MAY OCTOBER After 11:00am, irrespective of the day, a member may host seven guests at one time (two groups) at the respective guest rate.
- NOTE the member must play in one of the groups.
- The same guest may play a maximum of six (6) times per calendar year. Member-Guest tournaments and Inter-Club matches are excluded from these counts.
- · All respective guest fees at any time of year shall go on the member's account.

UNACCOMPANIED GUESTS

• NOVEMBER - APRIL After 1:00pm, irrespective of the day, one unaccompanied group may be sponsored per membership. Any request shall be made to the Director of Golf or Head Golf Professionals, only within three (3) days of the respective day. Advance tee time requests through ForeTees is not permitted for unaccompanied play.

- MAY OCTOBER Any unaccompanied group request may be made to the Director of Golf or Head Golf Professionals.
- The respective unaccompanied guest fee shall go on the member's account.
- Caddie requirements:
- Year Round: All unaccompanied groups must take a Forecaddie at a minimum when playing the Match or Medal course.

FAMILY GUESTS

• Family guests are defined as having a vertical relation (children, grandchildren, parents, and any in-laws of the such) shall be entitled to the respective family guest fee.

DRESS CODE

GOLF COURSE & PRACTICE FACILITIES

All players and accompanying individuals

- Collared shirts with either a traditional fold-down collar or a mock collar must be worn and tucked in
- Shorts must be of appropriate length
- Headwear must be worn with the bill facing forward.
- Appropriate golf soft spike shoes are required which may consist of an athletic tennis/walking shoe as well.
- Locker rooms must be used for changing shoes (the parking lot is not permitted).

NOT PERMITTED

- Tank tops, halter tops, t-shirts and jogging outfits
- Cut-off shorts or pants
- Racquet attire / jogging outfits / gym shorts
- Jeans
- Cargo shorts or pants (cargo shorts/pants are defined having a bulging exterior pocket(s))
- Swimwear

WOMEN

- Shirts and tops must be appropriate golf shirts
- Headwear must be worn with the bill facing forward.
- Dresses, skirts and shorts must be of an appropriate golf length.
- Tennis length skirts and dresses are not permitted.
- Appropriate golf soft spike shoes are required which may consist of an athletic tennis/walking shoe as well.
- Locker rooms must be used for changing shoes (the parking lot is not permitted).

NOT PERMITTED

- Tank tops
- T-Shirts
- Spaghetti Straps
- Swimwear
- Jeans

Please note that some items sold in the Golf Shop are designed for lifestyle pieces and are not considered appropriate attire for clubhouse or golf wear. Any questions regarding attire should be directed to a Golf Professional.

GOLF CLUB TOWELS & LOCKER RENTAL

- •The respective club towels in each area are for use on club property only.
- The Club is not responsible for loss of valuables, clothes, shoes or other personal property from an individual locker, the locker room or bag storage room.

TOURNAMENT ELIGIBILITY & INFO

MGA. WGA. L9. TWILIGHT. "J"ENTS & "L"ADIES -**ALL EVENTS**

- Eligible for Golf and Executive Members.
- To be eligible to participate in any MGA, WGA, or L9 event, the respective membership and its associated costs and dues must be paid.

JUNIOR ACCESS

- A junior golfer is defined as a Golf Member's dependent under the age of sixteen (16).
- Any junior ages twelve (12) sixteen (16) may play anytime on any course, and must follow the respective rules and regulations.
- Juniors ages twelve (12) and over are allowed to participate in all Association and club tournaments provided they pay the respective Association dues.
- NOTE Participation in Club Championships will be for Championship Flight division only with a handicap index of
- Member's children under the age of twelve (12) must be accompanied by an adult Golf Member at all times.

HOUSE MEMBERS

• House and Racquet Members may play as a guest of a Golf, Executive or Sport Member a maximum of two times per calendar month and a maximum of six times per year.
